

**CHAP. 305.** the company, at such times and in such manner as they or a board as aforesaid shall direct.

**To be personal estate**  
**Assignable**  
**Liability**

**SEC. 8.** *And be it enacted,* That the shares of said capital stock, as to all legal purposes shall be deemed and considered as personal estate, and shall be assignable in such manner and under such restrictions as the by-laws and ordinances, to be made by the president and directors or a board thereof shall direct, and that all property, estate and print stock of said corporation shall be bound and answerable for any contracts, or engagements made or liability incurred by the president and directors thereof, or through their agency, or by their authority, and that service of any judicial process by any authorised officer upon the president or any two directors, shall be a good service upon the corporation.

**Power to tax reserved**

**SEC. 9.** *And be it enacted,* That nothing contained in this act shall be construed to restrict the right of the Legislature to impose, from time to time and at all times hereafter, such reasonable tax upon the property, real, personal and mixed, in which the capital stock of the company hereby incorporated shall be invested, in common with similar property of any other corporation or individual of this State.

**To be in force till 1865**

**SEC. 10.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall continue in force until the first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, and until the end of the next session of the general assembly which shall happen thereafter.

**No banking privilege**

**SEC. 11.** *And be it enacted,* That nothing herein contained shall be construed to authorise the said company to exercise any banking privilege.
