CHAPTER 356.

*A supplement to an act, entitled, a supplement to an act, to Incorporate the Susquehanna and Patapsco Canal Company, passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter two hundred.* Passed May 20, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Tide Water Canal Company, incorporated by the act to which this is a supplement, shall be authorised to construct a Canal from the Northern line of the State to some point which may be determined upon, at or near the town of Havre de Grace, on the Susquehanna River, and to connect the said canal with the canal authorised to be constructed by the Susquehanna Canal Company of Pennsylvania, upon such terms, and subject to such stipulations and covenants as may be agreed upon between the two companies, and the canal hereby authorised shall be of at least equal size, dimensions and capacity in every respect, and shall be constructed upon a plan not inferior to that of the said Pennsylvania Canal; provided, that this act shall be void if the said canal shall not be completed within seven years from the passage of this act.*

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That the capital stock of the said company, shall be six hundred thousand dollars, in shares of fifty dollars each, and whenever eight thousand shares of the said stock shall have been subscribed, then the said subscribers and stockholders and their successors, shall be, and they hereby are incorporated by the name of the Tide Water Canal Company, under the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, and the act to incorporate the Susquehanna and Patapsco Canal Company, so far as the same may be applicable and necessary to the organization*
