The death casualties in the 1st Maryland Cavalry were as follows: Killed in battle, three (3) commissioned officers and sixty-five (65) enlisted men—total, sixty-eight (68); died of wounds, disease, etc., three (3) commissioned officers and one hundred and thirty (130) enlisted men—total, one hundred and thirty-three (133), or an aggregate death list of two hundred and one (201).
