

fied voters of the State of Maryland who are absent [and engaged in the Military or Naval Service of the United States] at the time of any election from the ward or election district in which they are entitled to vote, and for the manner in which and the time and place at which such absent voters may vote, and for the canvass and return of their votes.

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the foregoing section, hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of this State, shall, at the election to be held in November 1954, be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of the State for their adoption or rejection, in pursuance of the directions contained in Article 14 of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, and at the said general election the vote on the said proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be by ballot, upon each ballot there shall be printed the words: "For Constitutional Amendment", and "Against Constitutional Amendment", as now provided by law, and immediately after said election due returns shall be made to the Governor of the vote for and against proposed amendment, as directed by said Fourteenth Article of the Constitution, and further proceedings had in accordance with said Article 14.

CHAPTER 481

(House Bill 141)

AN ACT to add two new sections to Title 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore County (1948 Edition), being Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County," title "Health and Sanitation," to be under the new subtitle "Public Bathing Beaches," said new sections to be known as Sections 155A and 155B of said title and to follow immediately after Section 155 thereof, authorizing the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to require lifeguards to be in attendance at public bathing beaches and swimming pools in Baltimore County.
