CHAP. LXXXV.

Passed Jan 30 1821 An Act to repeal all that part of the Constitution and Form of Government as relates to the division of Washington County into five separate Election Districts, and for other purposes.

Part of constitution 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all that part of the constitution and form of government, whereby Washington county liath been divided and laid off into five sepaon repealed rate election districts, be and the same is hereby repealed.

County divided . 2. And be it enacted, That Washington county shall be divided into 7 districts into saven serverate election districts. into seven separate election districts, and that the election for the additional districts shall be held as follows: The one at the town of Bounshorough, and the other at Cave-Town.

Elections for die 1 3. And be it enacted, That the place for holding the elections triet No. 2 to be for election district number two, in Washington county, shall held in Williams for election district number two, in hereafter be held at Williamsport.

Act. if confirmed, 4. And be it enacted, That if this act shall be confirmed by the general assembly of Maryland, after the next election of delegates, in the first session after such new election, as the constituto be part of contion and form of government directs, in such case this act, and the alterations herein contained, shall constitute and be considered as a part of the said constitution and form of government, to all intents and purposes, any thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAP. LXXXVI.

Pased Jan 27 1821 An Additional Supplement to the act, entitled. An act to provide for the Education of Poor Children in Kent, Talbot, Cecil, Anne-Arundel and Montgomery Counties.
