

CHAPTER 166.

AN ACT to provide for a General Index of Judgments in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county be and he is hereby authorized and directed to procure Campbell's Patent, if the one now in use is not sufficient, suitable for a General Index to Judgments which have been entered upon the records of his office since the June term, eighteen hundred and seventy-one, thereof, and have the same indexed in the name of all the defendants in a legible and clerical manner, and after the completion of said index the said clerk and his successors in office are hereby required to keep up said index by entering thereupon, after each term of court, all judgments that may thereafter be rendered, to be paid for by the defendants in said judgments as other costs are now paid.

Clerk directed to procure index.

Required to keep up

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the County Commissioners of Prince George's county be and they are hereby directed to pay the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Prince George's county, at the first annual levy after the completion of said work, the same compensation as is now allowed for making alphabetical lists of transfers of property, upon the presentation of a certificate of one of the judges of the Circuit Court of the seventh judicial circuit that said work and labor has been properly performed.

Commissioners directed to pay.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
