CHAPTER 397.

AN ACT to repeal section eighteen of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Alleghany county," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact said section with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section eighteen of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Alleghany county," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted.

18. He shall be entitled to such compensation as shall be fixed by the county commissioners, and he shall have power to administer oaths to all road supervisors who come before said commissioners to settle their accounts, touching the fairness and truth of such accounts, and to all persons who come before said commissioners to make transfers, or ask for rebates or reductions, or other changes in assessments on the assessment books of said county, and shall have power to take affidavits to all papers to be filed in the office of said commissioners.
