

- a body corporate, originally incorporated by the act of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-five, entitled "An act to incorporate the president and directors of 'The Firemen's Insurance Company of Baltimore,'" by changing the name of the said corporation, to "The Firemen's Insurance Company of Baltimore," and by repealing section twelve of the said act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-five, and also, by repealing the acts of eighteen hundred and twenty-six, chapter one hundred and seventy-one, eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, chapter forty-one, and eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter one hundred and sixty-eight, and section eleven of said act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-five, and the re-enactment thereof by section four of the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, chapter thirty-three, all of which acts are supplements to or amendments of the said act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-five, and by likewise amending the act of eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter thirty-three, and the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, chapter two hundred and twenty, both of which acts are also supplements to or amendments of the said acts of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-five, and by further adding an additional section to the said act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-five. 198
- No. 144. An act to amend the charter of the Woodberry Manufacturing Company, incorporated under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of 1868, chapter 463. 201
- No. 145. An act to pay to William Flaherty fifty-four dollars and fifty-seven cents, to refund money paid by him to the State Treasurer for license, and to pay to William Henry and Mary J. Beecher fifty-seven dollars and refund to them a proportionate part of money paid by them to the State Treasurer for season's dredging license. 203
- No. 146. An act to appropriate a sum of money to pay R. C. Mackall for expenses incurred under an appointment made by His Excellency Elihu E. Jackson, late Governor of Maryland, as a delegate to the Southern Emigration Convention, held at Asheville, North Carolina, in December eighteen hundred and ninety. 204
- No. 147. An act to repeal sections one hundred and fifteen, one hundred and sixteen and one hundred and seventeen of article eight of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "County Commissioners." 205
