No. 14. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section six of article sixty-five of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Militia." 15

No. 15. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one hundred and forty-nine of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Coroner's Inquest and Dead Bodies," and re-enacted by chapter two hundred and seven of the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed January session eighteen hundred and ninety. 16
