

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore" sub-title "Licenses," to be known as "Section 664 A," in reference to the placing of telegraph, telephone and electric light poles in the streets, lanes and alleys of said city.

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the assessment, valuation and taxation of ten millions of dollars of the increased capital stock of the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Company, as ratified by the stockholders at their annual meeting, November 11th, 1891

House bill entitled an Act to amend the Charter of the Baltimore Belt Railroad Company, as amended by the Act of the General Assembly, passed at the Session of 1890, chapter 139, entitled an Act to provide for the mode of constructing and operating the railroad of the Baltimore Belt Railroad Company in Baltimore city and county.

House bill entitled an Act to pay Ross Compton, late Collector of Taxes for Garrett county, the amount of money over-paid by him into the State Treasury for 1888 and 1889.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 19, of Article 9, Public General Laws, title "Attachments," and to re-enact the same.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 1, Article 76, of the Code of Public General Laws, with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 26, of Article 9, Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Attachments."

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Louis H. Rehn \$122.75, as commission on money collected by him as Collector and Treasurer of the city of Annapolis.

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Tabb and Jenkins Hardware Company of Baltimore city.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 252, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Elections."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 60, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws, title
