House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors in School District No. 5, Election District No. 9, of Worcester county.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re enact section 57, of Article 24, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Birds and Game."

House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Roads," to follow after section 177, and to be numbered 177 A.

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit drunkenness and disorderly conduct in Liberty District, Frederick county, Md.

House bill entitled an Act to sanction the bequest of John Young of C. to the Evangelical Church of Frederick, of the residue of the testator's estate, to be applied to the Evangelical Lutheran Sunday School of Frederick city, Md.

House bill entitled an Act empowering the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to acquire certain land in the City of Baltimore, for the purpose of extending Eutaw Square from Dolphin to Biddle streets.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments an Act entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore city to make annual appropriations for the benefit of the Maryland Industrial School for "Girls," now called "Female House of Refuge."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 116 C, of Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "County Treasurer," and to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 116 B, 116 E, 116 F, 116 G and 117, of said Article, and respective sections appear in chapter 137, of the Acts of 1890, and to add to said Article a new section to follow immediately after section 117, to be designated as section 117 A.
