House bill entitled an Act to repeal, amend and re-enact section 614, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Justice of the Peace and Constables," as amended by chapter 230, of the Act passed at the January Session of 1890.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 83, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Cambridge," as amended by the Act of 1890, chapter 311, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
