

## CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy a sum of money to pay certain assessors appointed under the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and sixty, generally known as the assessment act.

Commissioners authorized to levy.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to include in the annual levy for county purposes the sum of five hundred and eighty-eight dollars, to be applied as follows: to be paid to Patrick O. Brien, the sum of one hundred and ninety-six dollars, for forty-nine days services as one of the assessors of Baltimore county, after the time limited by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six; to be paid to Henry A. Nagle, the sum of one hundred and ninety-six dollars, for forty-nine days services as aforesaid, and to William T. Faithful, the sum of one hundred and ninety-six dollars, for forty-nine days services as aforesaid.

In force.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
