

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Nancy Donovan, late of Allegany county, Maryland, deceased, to Saint Patrick's Catholic Church of Cumberland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the bequest of Nancy Donovan, late of Allegany county, Maryland, deceased, to Saint Patrick's Catholic Church of Cumberland, as contained in her nuncupative will admitted to probate in the Orphans' Court of said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT giving sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a bequest, legacy and devise in the last will and testament of George Stonebraker, late of Baltimore city, deceased, to the Lutheran and German Reformed Congregation of Funkstown, Washington county, Maryland.

Preamble. Whereas George Stonebraker, late of Baltimore city, deceased, did, by his last will and testament, dated the thirty-first day of August, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, give and devise a house and lot in Boonsborough, Washington county, Maryland, to his black woman "Tilly," to whom he also gave freedom, with sixty dollars yearly during her life, and after her decease, the said house and lot, and annuity of sixty dollars, to the sole
