Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Seibert and Wirt.

House bill entitled an Act to add a section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 59, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Destroying Property Maliciously."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Article 61, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Manures and Fertilizers."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Labor.
