Senate bill entitled an Act to punish misconduct at primary elections in Montgomery county.

Senate bill entitled an Act to be added to the Code of Public Local Laws, of Article 4, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," an additional section, providing for a Stenographer to the Grand Jury of Baltimore city.

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the destruction of the weed or plant known as the "Canada Thistle," on lands in Queen Anne's county.

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city to employ an additional clerical officer.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 196, of Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, subtitle "Guardians and Infants not residing in this State," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Baltimore, Canton and Point Breeze Railway Company of Baltimore city, by authorizing it to lease, purchase or aid other railroads or to consolidate with the same.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Administration."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 32, of Article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 64, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title ". evenue and Taxes."

Senate bill entittled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 236, of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hancock."

Senate bill entitled an Act authorizing and directing the return of certain moneys to William W. Evans and William P. Barnes, of Somerset county, paid as fixes for violation of an Act of Assembly that had been repealed.
