

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Baltimore, Canton and Point Breeze Railway Company of Baltimore city, by authorizing it to lease, purchase or aid other railroads or to consolidate with the same.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend an Act entitled "an Act to incorporate the Baltimore Traction Company of Baltimore city, and to enable said company to use the electric power known as the Trolley System, for the propulsion of its cars upon its railways."

Which were read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, Article 45, title "Husband and Wife," by adding an additional section thereto, to be known as Section 19, under the sub-title of "An Act to quiet the title to property passing from husband to wife."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.
