

obtain for the same; provided, they shall not be sold for less than par and accrued interest.

“Sec. 4. Be it further enacted, That the actual cash proceeds of the sales of the certificates of indebtedness to be issued under this Act shall be paid to the Treasurer of this State upon the warrant of the Comptroller, and such proceeds shall be used exclusively as far as the same are required for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, to-wit: The sum of \$600,000 for the purpose of completing and repairing the State House, in the city of Annapolis; \$200,000 for the purpose of completing the construction of an annex to the Maryland House of Correction; \$200,000 for the purpose of the completion of the Springfield State Hospital; \$66,000 for the purpose of construction and completion of the buildings of the Maryland Asylum and Training School for the Feeble Minded; \$57,000 for the purpose of construction and completion of buildings of the Maryland Agricultural College; \$53,000 for the purpose of the construction and completion of buildings for the Maryland Hospital for the Insane; \$10,000 for the purpose of construction of buildings for the Cambridge Hospital; \$5,000 for the purpose of construction of buildings for Charlotte Hall School; \$5,000 for the purpose of construction of buildings for St. Mary's Academy; \$4,000 for the purpose of construction of buildings for St. Mary's Female Seminary; \$175,000 for the purchase of a lot of ground in the city of Baltimore, for the Maryland Institute, and the construction of a building thereon; and \$250,000 for the Relief Fund Commission, under chapter 129 of the Acts of 1904; and the said respective sums shall be paid by the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller to the person or persons, commission or commissions, body or bodies corporate, entitled to receive the same, upon written orders from time to time as such sums may be required. And the Building Commission created by an Act passed at the January Session of 1902, chapter 332, to erect said addition to the State House, being hereby declared entitled to receive the first-named sum of \$600,000, and the Board of Managers of the Maryland House of Correction, being
