House bill entitled an Act to add additional Sections to Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Emmitsburg," authorizing and empowering the Burgess and Commissioners of Emmitsburg to widen the public street leading from the public square, in said town, to the depot of Emmitsburg R. R. Company, to be known as sub-Sections A and B to the charter of said town.
