Mr. Gorman submitted the following amendment :

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 3, strike out all after the word "pay," to the end of the section, and insert "to the order of Henry E. Dennison, of Annapolis, the sum of one hundred dollars out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Harwood Iglehart, surviving partner of James Iglehart.
