ROOMS OF THE COMMITTEE ON CLAIMS,
Annapolis, January 19th, 1876.

To the Gentlemen of the House of Delegates of Maryland:

In response to the order of the House, adopted January 18, 1876, making inquiry as to what persons had received pay under the order of the House, adopted January 13th, 1876, viz:

Ordered, That the subordinate officers of the last House, on duty in this House since its organization, be allowed five dollars per diem for the time they were on duty, and necessary traveling expenses to and from Annapolis.
