

On motion of Mr. Loane,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to amend the Act of January Session, 1860, chapter 265, entitled an Act to incorporate the Consolidation Coal Company, by repealing the sixth Section thereof, and enacting an additional Section in lieu thereof.

Mr. Loane, Chairman of the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to add additional Sections to Article 26, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporators," as enacted by Act of Assembly, 1868, chapter 471, and to restrict the powers of Corporations formed for the loaning of money upon mortgage of real and leasehold estate.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 2 and 3, of the Act passed January Session, 1868, to incorporate the Parkton and Manchester Railroad Company, and re-enact the same to read as follows.

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Stock Exchange of the City of Baltimore.
