With the following amendment:

Insert "Allegary and Carroll" after the word "Garrett," and make the word "County" read "Counties," wherever it occurs in the bill,

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate lill entitled an Act to repeal Section 42, of Article 37, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Evidence," sub-title "Proof of Foreign Debts and other Instruments," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 205, 206 and 212, of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, relating to the City of Baltimore, sub-title "Elections," and to re-enact Sections 205, 206 and 212, with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact Section 79, and sub-Section 2, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "County Commissioners," as amended and re-enacted by chapter 485, of the Acts of 1874.

Senate bill entitle an Act to incorporate the purchasers of the Queen Anne's and Kent County Railroad Company.
