

Chapter 344.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Comptroller of the Treasury to pay to the public schools the sum of thirty-four thousand and sixty-nine dollars and thirty-six cents, due to the public school fund for the year eighteen hundred and seventy seven.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it has been represented to this General Assembly that the sum of thirty-four thousand and sixty-nine dollars and thirty-six cents, being one-fifth of the revenue derived from the tax on the Washington Branch of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, due and payable to the free school fund under the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-six, chapter two hundred and twenty, and the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter thirty-three, remains unpaid, as appears by the Comptroller's report for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, and the certificate of the present Comptroller; now, therefore—

Directed to distribute.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to distribute, and the Treasurer to pay, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to the schools of the several counties of the State and the city of Baltimore respectively, on the first day of July next, the aforesaid sum of thirty-four thousand and sixty-nine dollars and thirty-six cents, in addition to the amount at that time to be distributed on account of the free school fund.
