

Chapter 65.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the "Shelter for Aged and Infirm Colored Persons of Baltimore city" so as to allow an increase in the number of managers to thirty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the charter of the "Shelter for Aged and Infirm Colored Persons of Baltimore city," a corporation incorporated under the provisions of the general law of Maryland, be and the same is hereby amended so as to provide that said corporation shall be managed by such number of managers not exceeding thirty-six, nor less than seven, as the by-laws of said corporation may provide; and that until the regular time for the election of managers as prescribed by said by-laws, the managers of said corporation shall be the following, viz.: Isabella Tyson, Margaret H. White, M. Alice Brooks, Mary Crook, Sally W. Deford, Jane P. Winslow, Mary C. Blackburn, Martha L. Carey, Sarah R. Tyson, Margaret H. Elliott, Margaret W. Fisher, Sally D. Williams, Emily I. Albert, Maria L. Eaton, Hannah M. Pope, Isabella Morris, Ida P. Jones, Ann M. Sears, Bettie W. Hopkins, Mary N. Perry, Marian L. Ramsay, Sally B. Steuart, Maria P. Handy, Sidney C. Harris, Emma L. Thomsen, Anne I. Kirk, Ellen Irvin, Maud G. Early, Mary McCullough and Anna Reed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the duration of said corporation shall be unlimited, and this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
