SEC. 8. And be it further enacted, That said election shall be by ballot which shall be in the following form:

## "OFFICIAL BALLOT

The Congress of the United States has proposed an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to read as follows:

Section 1. The Eighteenth Article of Amendment to the Constitution of the United States is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The transportation or importation in any State, Territory, or Possession of the United States for delivery or use therein of intoxicating liquors in violation of the law thereof is hereby prohibited.

Section 3. This Article shall be inoperative unless it shall have been ratified as an amendment to the Constitution by Conventions in the several States, as provided in the Constitution within seven years from the date of the submission hereof to the States by the Congress."
