Section 1. Be it enacted by the Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction of the general assembly be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above-mentioned gift of the said Adam L. Jacobs.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 114.

AN ACT to repeal section fifty of article twenty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "County Commissioners," sub-title "Bridges," and to re-enact said section with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section fifty of article twenty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "County Commissioners," sub-title "Bridges," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows.

Sec. 50. All bridges shall be built or repaired by contract, and the county commissioners shall advertise in one or more newspapers, and if there be no newspapers published in the county or counties, then by such public notice as they may deem most advisable, setting forth the place where said bridge is to be built or repaired, with full specifications of the plan and materials, and that sealed proposals for building or repairing said bridge will be received until a day named in the advertisement; provided, however, that nothing herein shall apply to the building of bridges, the cost of which shall not exceed two-hundred dollars, nor to repairs of existing bridges, where the cost of said repairs shall not exceed that sum; and in all cases where such cost of building or repairing shall not exceed said sum of two-hundred dollars, the man-
