

be confined in said jail, and the services of such warden are, in the judgment of said sheriff and state's attorney for said county, necessary for the safekeeping of such prisoner or prisoners.

Compensation
of warden.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the compensation of such warden shall not exceed the sum of one dollar per day for the time so employed, and shall be levied by the county commissioners at their annual levy of taxes for said county.

Effective.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 273.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section fifty-five and sub-section one of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Rockville," as enacted by chapter ninety-seven of the act of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Enacted in lieu.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section fifty-five and sub-section one of chapter ninety-seven, as enacted by chapter ninety-seven of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following section and sub-section be and they are hereby enacted in lieu thereof:

Appoint judges
of election.

SEC. 55. The commissioners for Rockville shall, at their first meeting in the month of May next, appoint three judges of election for the town of Rockville, who shall be substantial citizens and residents in the corporate limits of said town for at least two years next preceding their appointment. The judges of election so appointed shall give at least two weeks' previous notice in the newspapers published at Rockville, of the time and place of holding an election for
