

*Be it resolved by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring,* That the "Act to regulate the taking of oysters in the Potomac river" takes effect and goes into force from and after the thirteenth day of March, eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

When operative

*Resolved by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring,* That the second section of the act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland and Virginia at this present session, entitled An act to regulate the taking of oysters from the Potomac river, shall be understood and construed: the having in possession of any oysters taken in the Potomac river, and not to forbid the transportation of oysters over the Potomac river, which were taken in other waters.
