

to adopt such by-laws as may be deemed necessary for the government of the Corps not inconsistent with the laws of this State, and to alter such by-laws at its discretion.

CHAPTER 114.

AN ACT to give and grant the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry sales, conveyances and deeds of various persons in this State to or for the use of sundry religious sects, orders and denominations.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction and consent of said General Assembly be and is hereby granted and given to the following sales, deeds and conveyances to or for the use of the several religious sects, orders and denominations hereafter set forth :

Sanction to following sales, &c.

Robert Oliver, grantor.

First. To the sale of Robert Oliver to the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Baltimore of certain property on the northwest side of Belairavenue in the city of Baltimore, and fully described in a deed dated July fifteenth, eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, and now recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore city, Liber W. G., No. one hundred and ninety-four, folio two hundred and six, etc., from said Oliver to the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Baltimore.

Second. To the sale of Daniel James Cummings, et al., to the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Baltimore of certain property on the
