to perform the duties imposed on them by this act; provided, that the architect so employed and the person to whom the contract for said building is awarded shall be bona fide residents of the State of Maryland.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the sum of fifty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the purposes of this act, and the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrants upon the Treasurer, payable to the order of the said Committee, for such sums and at such times as shall be required by the said Committee for the procurement of plans and specifications and the erection of the enlargement or annex hereby authorized and directed to be erected for the purposes aforesaid; provided, that a sum of not less than ten per centum of the whole cost of said enlargement or annex, shall be retained by the Treasurer from the amount to be paid for erection of the same until its final completion and acceptance by said Committee; and provided, further, that the said sum of fifty thousand dollars shall cover the entire cost of the plans and specifications for and construction of said enlargement or annex, including plumbing, shelving, painting and thorough equipment for use, except heating apparatus and furniture.

Appropriation.
