**CHAIRES (CHAIRS, CHEARES), JOHN** (?–1728/29). BORN: of age by 1717; eldest son. NATIVE: at least second generation. RESIDED: in Queen Anne's County. FAMILY BACKGROUND. FATHER: John Chaires (?–ca. 1718), of Queen Anne's County. STEPFATHER: (first name unknown) Collins. MOTHER: Catherine (?–by 1730). BROTHERS: Joseph; Thomas; and James. SISTERS: Hannah, who married (first name unknown) Ellis; Catherine (?–by 1730). MARRIED Mary, who subsequently married *Solomon Clayton* (1685–1739). CHILDREN. SONS: John (?–1747), who married Margaret; Thomas; and James. PRIVATE CAREER. EDUCATION: literate. RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION: Anglican, St. Paul's Parish, Queen Anne's County, and later St. Luke's Parish, Queen Anne's County. OCCUPATIONAL PROFILE: probably a planter. PUBLIC CAREER. LEGISLATIVE SERVICE: Lower House, Queen Anne's County, 1722–1724, 1725–1727. LOCAL OFFICE: Old Chester Church Vestry, St. Paul's Parish, Queen Anne's County, 1725–1728. WEALTH DURING LIFETIME. LAND AT FIRST ELECTION: at least 350 acres in Queen Anne's County. WEALTH AT DEATH. DIED: between January 15 and February 4, 1728/29, in Queen Anne's County. **CHAMBERLAINE, JAMES LLOYD** (1732–1783). BORN: on October 10, 1732, in Oxford, Talbot County; second son. NATIVE: second generation. RESIDED: in Talbot County; "Peach Blossom," Talbot County, 1771. FAMILY BACKGROUND. FATHER: *Samuel Chamberlaine* (1698–1773). MOTHER: Henrietta Maria (ca. 1711–1748), daughter of *James Lloyd* (1679/80–1723). UNCLE: *Robert Lloyd* (ca. 1712–1770). AUNTS: Margaret Lloyd (1714–ca. 1785), who married *William Tilghman* (1711–1782); Ann Lloyd (ca. 1723–1794), who married *Matthew Tilghman* (1717/18–1790). BROTHERS: Thomas (1731–1764); *Samuel Chamberlaine* (1742–1811); Richard; and Robert Lloyd. SISTERS: Anne (1734–1786), who married *Richard Tilghman Earle* (1728/29–1788); Henrietta Maria (1739–1777). FIRST COUSINS: *Richard Tilghman* (1740–1809); Margaret Tilghman (1742–1817), who married *Charles Carroll, Barrister* (1723–1783); Deborah Lloyd, who married *Peregrine Tilghman* (ca. 1741–1807); and

MARRIED on May 16, 1757, Henrietta Maria (1736–1791), daughter of *George Robins* (1697–1742); stepdaughter of *William Goldsborough* (1709–1760); granddaughter of both *Thomas Robins* (1672–1721) and *Richard Tilghman* (1672/73–1738/39); niece of *William Tilghman* (1711–1782), *Edward Tilghman* (1713–1786), *James Tilghman* (1716–1793), *Matthew Tilghman* (1717/18–1790), Mary Tilghman (1702–1736), who married *James Earle, Jr.* (ca. 1694–1739), and Anna Maria Tilghman (1709–1763), who married first, *William Hemsley* (1703–1736), and second, *Robert Lloyd* (ca. 1712–1770); half niece of Elizabeth Robins (1710–1746), who married *William Goldsborough* (1709–1760). Her brother was Thomas (1740–1762). Her sisters were Anna Maria (ca. 1732–1804), who married *Henry Hollyday* (ca. 1725–1789); Margaret (1734–1808), who married *William Hayward* (?–1791); Susanna (1738–?); and Elizabeth (1742–by 1764).
