

Elizabeth Ennalls, who married *Roger Woolford* (1670–1730); Ann Brooke, who married first, *Thomas Cooke* (?–1692/93). BROTHERS: *William Ennalls* (?–1731); *Joseph* (1702–1759); *Thomas* (?–1753); and *Henry* (?–1734). SISTERS: *Elizabeth* (?–by 1739), who married *Charles Goldsborough* (1707–1767); *Mary*, who married *Henry Hooper* (ca. 1687–1767). FIRST COUSIN: *Thomas Woolford* (ca. 1699–ca. 1750/51). NEPHEWS: *Joseph Ennalls* (ca. 1745–1779); *William Ennalls* (?–1785); *John Ennalls* (by 1746–ca. 1778); *Henry Hooper, Jr.* (ca. 1727–1790); and *Robert Goldsborough* (1733–1788). NIECES: *Mary Ennalls*, who married *Ennalls Hooper* (?–ca. 1763); *Ann Ennalls* (ca. 1729–by 1790), who married *Henry Hooper, Jr.* (ca. 1727–1790); *Elinor Ennalls* (ca. 1738–1793), who married *Joseph Daffin* (?–1796); and *Elizabeth Greenberry Goldsborough* (ca. 1731–1820), who married *William Ennalls* (?–1785). MARRIED first, by 1725 *Mary Smith*. MARRIED second, by 1735 *Elizabeth*, widow of *William Taylor* (?–1730); daughter of *Henry Trippe* (?–ca. 1723/24); stepdaughter of *John Eccleston*; granddaughter of *Henry Trippe* (1632–1697/98); half niece or step-niece of *John Brooke* (by 1646–1692/93). Her brothers were *Edward* (?–1772); *Henry Trippe* (?–1744); and *John*. Her sisters were *Sarah* (?–1755); *Mary* (?–1782), who married *Jacob Hindman* (by 1713–1766). Her nephews were *James Hindman* (1741–1830); *William Hindman* (1743–1822). Her nieces were *Elizabeth Hindman* (?–by 1788), who married *William Perry* (1746–1799); *Mary Emerson Trippe* (ca. 1739–1811), who married *Robert Goldsborough IV* (1740–1798); *Ann Trippe*, who married *John Dickinson* (ca. 1726–1789). CHILDREN. SONS: *Joseph* (1735–?), who resided in North Carolina by 1785; *Henry* (1739–?); *William* (1741–?); and *Bartholomew* (1746–?), who married first, in 1789 *Sally Hooper*, and second, *Nancy Keene*. DAUGHTERS: *Mary*; *Sarah*; *Elizabeth*; *Ann* (1737–?); and *Leath (Leah)* (1743–?). STEPDAUGHTER: *Mary Taylor*. PRIVATE CAREER. EDUCATION: literate. RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION: Protestant. SOCIAL STATUS AND ACTIVITIES: Gent., by 1736. OCCUPATIONAL PROFILE: mariner, 1718; probably also a planter. PUBLIC CAREER. LEGISLATIVE SERVICE: Lower House, Dorchester County, 1738, 1739–1741, 1742–1744, 1745 (Elections), 1745/46–1748 (Elections Cv 1, 1-3, 4). LOCAL OFFICES: justice, Dorchester County, by 1734—at least 1743 (quorum, 1734—at least 1743); sheriff, Dorchester County, 1749–1752; deputy commissary, Dorchester County, in office 1753–1755. MILITARY SERVICE: captain, by 1730; major, 1748; called colonel, 1776. WEALTH DURING LIFETIME.

PERSONAL PROPERTY: 27 slaves, 1776. LAND AT FIRST ELECTION: 659 acres in Dorchester County; also controlled 324 acres in Dorchester County for his stepdaughter, *Mary Taylor*. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: *Bartholomew* inherited 300 acres in Dorchester County from his uncle, *Thomas Ennalls* (?–1718). A few months later, in November 1718, *Bartholomew* exchanged this inherited land for 600 acres that his brother *William Ennalls* (?–1731) owned in Dorchester County. This land comprised the bulk of his acreage at first election. SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN LAND BETWEEN FIRST ELECTION AND DEATH: acquired 2,050 acres in Dorchester County by purchase or patent between 1747 and 1769; sold 569 acres in Dorchester County between 1749 and 1764. WEALTH AT DEATH. DIED: in 1783, probably in Dorchester County. PERSONAL PROPERTY: assessed value £1,357.10.10, including 25 slaves and 2.5 oz. plate, 1783; also paid taxes on 14 slaves for various other people, 1783. LAND: 1,590 acres in Dorchester County; not known if he still controlled 324 acres in Dorchester County for his stepdaughter.

ENNALLS (ENNOLDS, ENNALS), HENRY (1675–1734). BORN: in 1675 in Dorchester County; younger son. NATIVE: second generation. RESIDED: in Dorchester County. FAMILY BACKGROUND. FATHER: *Bartholomew Ennalls* (1643–1688). MOTHER: *Mary Heyward*. BROTHERS: *Thomas Ennalls* (?–1718), who married *Elizabeth* (1664/65–1739), daughter of *Roger Woolford* (?–ca. 1701/2); *William*; *Joseph Ennalls* (?–1709), who married *Mary*, daughter of *John Brooke* (by 1646–1692/93); and *Bartholomew*. HALF BROTHERS: *Francis Heyward*; *John Heyward*. SISTERS: *Elizabeth* (1664/65–1739), who married *Roger Woolford* (1670–1730); *Mary*. MARRIED *Mary* (1674–1745), daughter of *Henry Hooper* (ca. 1643–1720). Her brothers were *Richard*; *John* (?–1754); *Roger*; *Henry Hooper* (ca. 1687–1767); *Thomas*; and *James* (1703–1789). Her sisters were *Priscilla*; *Elizabeth*, who married *Matthew Travers* (ca. 1672–1742); *Rebecca*; *Ann* (1687–1767), who married *John Broome* (1676–ca. 1738/39); *Mary*, who married first, *Levin Hicks* (?–1731), son of *Thomas Hicks* (1659–1722), and second, *John Rider* (1686–1739/40); and *Rosannah*, who married *John Hudson*, *Quartus* (?–1751), son of *John Hudson* (1653–1730) and wife *Sarah*. CHILDREN. SONS: *Henry* (?–1770), who married *Margaret*; *Thomas*, who married *Ann*, daughter of *Andrew Skinner*; *Bartholomew* (?–by 1752); and *Joseph* (1709–1756), who married *Mary* (?–ca. 1772), widow of *Thomas Haskins* and daughter of *Govert Lookerman* (ca.
