LEGISLATIVE SERVICE: Lower House, Dorchester County, 1778–1779 (Grievances 3). LOCAL OFFICES: sheriff, Dorchester County, elected 1779, resigned 1781; collector of assessments on property, Dorchester County, in office 1780. WEALTH DURING LIFETIME. LAND AT FIRST ELECTION: 264 acres in Dorchester County (inherited from father). WEALTH AT DEATH. DIED: between December 12, 1782, and July 5, 1784, in Dorchester County. PERSONAL PROPERTY: assessed value £502.5.0, including 14 slaves and 3 oz. plate, 1783. LAND: 245 acres in Dorchester County.

**WOOLFORD, ROGER** (?–ca. 1701/2). IMMIGRATED: ca. 1663, as a free adult with wife from Northampton County, Virginia, where he had lived since at least 1660. RESIDED: in Manokin Hundred, Somerset County. MARRIED in March 1660/61 Mary, daughter of Levin Denwood of Northampton and Accomack counties, Virginia. Her brother was Levin (ca. 1648–1726), who married Priscilla. Her sisters were Susannah, who married Thomas Browne; and Rebecca, who married Nehemiah Covington (?–1713). Her nieces were Elizabeth Denwood (1674–1736), who married *George Gale* (1671–1712); Priscilla Covington, who married *Robert King* (1689–1755); Elizabeth Covington, who married *Benjamin Wailes* (?–ca. 1728/

29); and Sarah Covington (1683–1755), who married first, *Edward Lloyd* (1670–1718/19), and second, *James Hollyday* (1696–1747). CHILDREN. SONS: *Roger Woolford* (1670–1730); James (ca. 1680–1758), who married first, in 1698/99, Grace, daughter of *John Stevens* (?–1692), and second, Elizabeth, possible daughter of David Peterkin (?–1736); and Levin (1683–1721), who married Sarah (1691–?), daughter of Thomas Jones. DAUGHTERS: Mary (ca. 1663–?), who married *Henry Hooper* (ca. 1643–1720); Elizabeth (1664/65–1739), who married first, *Thomas Ennalls* (?–1718), and second, *William Holland* (?–1732); Rosannah (1666/67–?); Sarah (1672/73–by 1730), who married *Govert Lookerman* (ca. 1681–1728); and Ann (1675–?). PRIVATE CAREER. EDUCATION: literate. RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION: Anglican. SOCIAL STATUS AND ACTIVITIES: no title on arrival in Maryland. OCCUPATIONAL PROFILE: planter; frequently appeared as attorney in the Somerset County Court in the 1660s. PUBLIC CAREER. LEGISLATIVE SERVICE: Lower House, Somerset County, 1671–1674/75, 1676–1682, 1692–1693 (elected to the 1st session of the 1692–1693 Assembly to fill vacancy). LOCAL OFFICES: surveyor of highways, Somerset County, 1666; justice, Somerset County, 1676–1697. STANDS ON PUBLIC/PRIVATE ISSUES: hesitant to support Revolution of Protestant Associators in 1689. WEALTH DURING LIFETIME. LAND AT FIRST ELECTION: ca. 1,000 acres. WEALTH AT DEATH. DIED: will probated on February 26, 1701/2, in Somerset County. PERSONAL PROPERTY: TEV, at least £591.18.12 (including 1 servant and 5 slaves). LAND: 2,100 acres.

**WOOLFORD, ROGER** (1670–1730). BORN: in 1670, in Somerset County; eldest son. NATIVE: second generation. RESIDED: in Somerset County; Dorchester County after 1695. FAMILY BACKGROUND. FATHER: *Roger Woolford* (?–ca. 1701/2). MOTHER: Mary Denwood. BROTHERS: James (ca. 1680–1758); Levin (1683–1721).
