

NIFICANT CHANGES IN LAND BETWEEN FIRST ELECTION AND DEATH: Following 1757: Add "He sold the 485 acres owned at first election plus 37 acres in St. Mary's County in 1774." Delete next sentence. Add "Hicks's remaining lands were confiscated and sold during the Revolution." WEALTH AT DEATH. DIED: Delete "after 1784, probably." Add "will probated in 1788."

HILL, JOSEPH (ca. 1670–1724). FAMILY BACKGROUND. HALF SISTER: Mary Clarkson's first husband Thomas Francis: Add "(?–ca. 1686)."

HILL, RICHARD (ca. 1640–1700). IMMIGRATED: Delete "by 1659, possibly as an indentured servant." Add "probably in 1662, as an indentured servant." CHILDREN. STEPDAUGHTER: Mary Clarkson's first husband Thomas Francis: Add "(?–ca. 1686)."

HOLDSWORTH, THOMAS (ca. 1692–1718). CHILDREN. DAUGHTERS: Rebecca's husband Richard Young: Add "(1693–1748)."

HOLLAND, FRANCIS (ca. 1745–1795). FAMILY BACKGROUND. Delete "HALF SISTER." Add "STEP-SISTER." Susannah Hall: Add "(1744–ca. 1770)." Add "married second, *John Lee Webster* (ca. 1735–1795)."

HOLLAND, WILLIAM (?–1732). MARRIED second, Elizabeth Woolford's brothers: Add "James (1677–?); and Levin (1683–1721)." Her sisters were Mary: Add "(ca. 1663–?)." Add "Rosannah (1666/67–?)." Sarah: Delete "(1672–by 1730)." Add "(1672/73–by 1730)." Add "and Ann (1675–?)." Add "Her first cousins were Elizabeth Denwood (1674–1736), who married *George Gale* (1671–1712); Priscilla Covington, who married *Robert King* (1689–1755); Elizabeth Covington, who married *Benjamin Wailes* (?–ca. 1728/29); and Sarah Covington (1683–1755), who married first, *Edward Lloyd* (1670–1718/19), and second, *James Hollyday* (1696–1747). Her nephews were *Henry Hooper* (ca. 1687–1767); *Thomas Woolford* (ca. 1699–ca. 1750/51). HOLLINGSWORTH, JESSE (1732/33–1810). MARRIED second, Rachel's father Lyde Goodwin: Delete "(1725–1801)." Add "(1718–1755)." Her brother William: Add "who married Milcah Dorsey (1747–1829)." Her sisters: Add "Elizabeth, who married first, Henry Dorsey, and second, John Scott."

HOLMES, WILLIAM (ca. 1746–1825). FAMILY BACKGROUND. BROTHERS: John, who married Mary: Delete "Benson."

HOOE, ROBERT TOWNSHEND (ca. 1743–1809). FAMILY BACKGROUND. Add "FATHER: Rice Hooe (ca. 1702–1747/48)." Add "HALF BROTHER: Rice Hooe (1724/25–1757)." SISTER: Verlinda Harrison: Add "(1738/39–?)."

HOOPER, HENRY (ca. 1643–1720). MARRIED second, Mary: Add "(ca. 1663–?)." Her brothers were: Add "James (1677–?); and Levin (1683–1721)." Her sisters: Add "Rosannah (1666/67–?)." Sarah: Delete "(1672–by 1730)." Add "(1672/73–by 1730)." Add "and Ann (1675–?)." Add "Her first cousins were Elizabeth Denwood (1674–1736), who married *George Gale* (1671–1712); Priscilla Covington, who married *Robert King* (1689–1755); Elizabeth Covington, who married *Benjamin Wailes* (?–ca. 1728/29); and Sarah Covington (1683–1755), who married first, *Edward Lloyd* (1670–1718/19), and second, *James Hollyday* (1696–1747). Her nephew was *Thomas Woolford* (ca. 1699–ca. 1750/51). HOPKINS, NATHANIEL (?–1739/40). CHILDREN. DAUGHTERS: Dennis: Delete entry. Add "(?–1776), who married first, by 1739, David Johnson (?–1753), and second, Lemuel Purnell (?–1772)."
