

1 business is to prevent the Legislature, it is said it
2 is done to create some jobs so the fellows in the Legis-
3 lature could get them, and I don't think we want the
4 special purpose authorities in the State to be created
5 for the Legislatures.

6 MRS. BOTHE: I wonder, I know it is possible.
7 I know a number of the members of the Legislatures have
8 gone on the bench, but they haven't been such bad mem-
9 bers of the bench. Is the Committee actually going on
10 experience which would dictate, require this kind of
11 thing, or is it just a possibility that it may work
12 grievously in the future, because from what my own
13 knowledge is, it really has not been abused to my knowl-
14 edge to the extent it would justify this kind of
15 restriction in the Constitution which might run into all
16 kinds of unforeseen roadblocks.

17 DR. BARD: In answer to your question, we
18 would say that had this Section not been in the Consti-
19 tution, we believe that there would be abuses despite
20 the fact that there have been some exceptions to the
21 Section; nevertheless, in theory, it certainly holds true
