the world that knows what that means; whereas the present Maryland Constitution, Excessive bail shall not be required, and the United States Constitution provides the same. That is it, and in both cases, this has been sufficient so that under the rules of criminal procedure in both the State and the Federal Government, the detailed provisions then, there shall be a right to bail, subject to these limitations.

MR. SAYRE: This I see the problem of, and I don't want to put this in a motion, but I wonder if you could reconsider having counsel at each stage of the prosecution, et cetera, just because that would take care probably of this problem, too.

THE CHAIRMAN: This is one of the questions being studied and referenced back to the Committee of the other sections, Section 7.

Is there any further question on Section 9? If not, we will suspend.
