

and its Appendix.<sup>62</sup>

Warner and Hanna also brought out Baltimore's second directory, entitled the Baltimore Directory for 1799,<sup>63</sup> edited by John Mullin. George Keatinge had projected a second directory in 1797, to be published in January of 1798;<sup>64</sup> but as far as is known, Warner and Hanna's was the next to be published after Pochin's directory of 1796. The New Baltimore Directory, and Annual Register for 1800 and 1801<sup>65</sup> was also a Warner and Hanna publication.

During 1800, this firm was the publisher of three of the several funeral orations printed in Maryland on the late President, George Washington, those by Bishop (later Archbishop) John Carroll,<sup>66</sup> Thomas Morrell, elder in the Methodist Episcopal Church,<sup>67</sup> and the oration delivered in Congress by Major General Henry Lee.<sup>68</sup>

The extent and progress of this firm's printing business may be noted, to some extent, at least, from this extract from an advertisement appearing on December 6, 1799:
