**TREASURER OF
WESTERN SHORE.**

1st May next, shall file with him their relinquishment of all right to any lotteries heretofore granted; provided, that said payments shall in no one year exceed \$5,000; and provided further, that the whole amount so paid shall not exceed \$40,994 06,

Upon payment and investment on or before the 1st April next, by the Commercial and Farmers of Baltimore \$9,533 33 $\frac{1}{2}$, upon 286 reserved shares in said bank, for the use of the state, and also upon payment to the treasurer of the Western Shore, of all or any balance of the bonus reserved for the support of freeschools, which may in the opinion of said treasurer be due by said bank; in that case the right of the state to appoint directors of the said bank shall cease and become void,

The right of the treasurer of the Western Shore to vote in person or by proxy, on behalf of the state or of the several counties, for directors, and at all general meetings of the stockholders of said bank, according to the share of stock owned, &c.

Authorised to appropriate to the current expenses of the year 1828, all the money which he may receive from the purchase of the right of the state to subscribe to 1000 shares of the capital stock of the Union Bank of Maryland, instead of investing the same in the stock of said bank,
