It shall be unlawful to place in the waters of said county any trot or outline baited with either live or dead bait Unlawful to or take fish in any of the waters of said county with haul outline, etc., seine, drag net or other devise other than by angling with rod, line and angle hook, baited with natural or artificial bait, under a penalty of \$5 for each trot line so placed and of \$2 for each fish taken in violation of this section.

SEC. 4. It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation Unlawful to to place or permit to be placed in any of the waters of said county any sawdust or poison or other substance hurtful to fish life, or to use any dynamite or explosive in said waters, except for engineering or mining purposes, under a penalty of not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for each and every offense.
