Bachtell, late of Washington county, Maryland, deceased, recorded among the testamentary records of Washington county, in Wills, Liber II, folio 294, in words following, to wit: "It is my desire that my executor, from the funds thus invested, pay each year, to each of the consistories of St. Peter's (or Beard's Church) and Reformed Church at Cave-town, towards the salaries of the pastors of those churches, and thus to continue until all is consumed; that he pays one dollar and fifty cents to the Lutheran of St. Peter's, and one dollar and twenty-five cents to the Reformed."
