the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to regulate the fees of the county surveyor of Garrett county," and chapter one hundred and one of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to repeal section twenty-two of chapter one hundred and eight of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled 'An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled Garrett county,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments, providing for additional pay to the crier of the circuit court, and sections twenty-one and twenty-two of chapter one hundred and eight of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled Garrett county," sub-titles "County Surveyor" and "Crier," respectively, be and they are hereby repealed.

Chapter 4.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and eight of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, entitled "An act to lay out and establish a new election district in Garrett county, out of the first and tenth election districts, and to be called district number twelve."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter two hundred and eight of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, entitled "An act to lay out and establish a new
