

CHAPTER 243.

AN ACT to amend the ninth Article in the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Assignment of Choses in action by adding a section thereto relating to the Assignment of Judgments obtained by the State. Passed Mar. 10, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following section relating to the assignment of judgments obtained by the State, shall be added to the ninth Article of the Code Public General Laws, entitled, Assignment of Choses in action, to follow the seventh section of said Article : Section added.

In any case where judgment shall be recovered by the State against any principal debtor and a surety or sureties, and said judgment shall be satisfied by said surety or sureties, the same shall be entered by the Attorney representing the State to the use of the surety or sureties satisfying the same, on the said Attorney filing in the case a certificate of the Comptroller stating that said judgment has been so satisfied, and said surety or sureties shall then be entitled to execution in his or their own name or names against the principal and the other sureties, in the same manner and subject to the same provisions provided in the two last preceding sections. Judgment recovered.

CHAPTER 244.

AN ACT to add the following section to the fourth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, relating to the Board of Police, so as to give a salary to the Clerk of the Board. Passed Mar. 10, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* as follows, to be added to Article Section added.
