

PUBLIC DEBT.

For the payment of the interest on the public debt of this State, that is to say: the interest falling due quarterly on the currency debt of the State, four hundred and twenty thousand dollars; and the interest on the public debt falling due semi-annually, and payable in London, including the cost of exchange, remittance and commissions, three hundred and forty thousand dollars; for the payment of the interest on the Bounty Loan of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, one hundred and eighty thousand dollars; for the interest on the bonds of the Annapolis and Elk Ridge Railroad Company, issued under chapter three hundred and forty-one of eighteen hundred and forty-six, two thousand seven hundred and twelve dollars and ninety-two cents.
