CHAPTER 186.

Passed March
7, 1862.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Howard county to levy a certain sum to be applied to building an addition to the County Jail.

Commission-
ers authorized

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Commissioners of Howard county, be and they are hereby authorized to levy in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two, upon the taxable property of said county, a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars, to be applied under the supervision of said Commissioners, to building such addition to the County Jail as they may deem necessary for the health and safe keeping of prisoners; and the provisions of the sixty-first Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the Mechanics' Lien, shall not apply to the said addition, or to the jail itself, on account of said addition.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
