Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the regular time or times for the election of the said Committee; shall hereafter be as appointed by the said act of incorporation; *provided*, that if the members of the said Church, qualified by law, shall fail to elect new members of the said Committee at such time or times, a new election may be held at any subsequent time, on the same notice as now required by law; *and provided further*, that the members of the old Committee, shall hold over till such new election shall be held.

## CHAPTER 261.

AN ACT to allow Samuel L. Duhamel, collector of taxes for the First Election District of Queen Anne's county, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, further time to complete his collections.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Samuel L. Duhamel, late a collector of the State and county taxes for the First Election district of Queen Anne's county, be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered, for twelve months from the passage of this act, to complete his collections as collector of State and county taxes in the Election District before named, with
