CHAPTER 635.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Board of County Commissioners for Kent County, Maryland, to pay unto Harrison W. Vickers, Jr., the State's Attorney for Kent County, Maryland, certain expenses incurred by him in the investigation and trial of the cases of the State of Maryland vs. Norman Mable and James Parraway, amounting, in the aggregate, to the sum of \$219.71.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners for Kent County, Maryland, are hereby authorized and directed to pay unto Harrison W. Vickers, Jr., the State's Attorney for Kent County, Maryland, the sum of \$219.71 for expenses incurred by him in the investigation and trial of the cases of the State of Maryland vs. Norman Mable and James Parraway for the murder of James R. Coleman, as follows:
