

and at any time after the first day of January next succeeding the date of the levy, and not before, payment may be enforced by sale as provided by law.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 660.

AN ACT to repeal Sections two and six of Chapter fifty-six of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of Session of 1882, codified as Sections 313 and 317 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Mechanicstown" (now Thurmont), and to substitute in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 2 and 6 of Chapter 56 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of the Session of 1882, codified as Sections 313 and 317 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Mechanicstown" (now Thurmont), be and the same are hereby repealed, and to substitute in lieu thereof the following:

SEC. 313. That the male citizens of said town of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, being citizens of the United States, who shall have resided in said town for and during the space of six months preceding, shall, on the second Monday of April in each and every year at the usual place of holding elections in said town, elect five commissioners, who shall have resided within the taxable limits of said town one year next preceding the election, one of whom shall be designated by the voters as president and another of whom shall be designated by the voters as secretary; the said commissioners shall enter upon the discharge of their duties within ten days after their election.

SEC. 317. The president shall preside at the meetings of said commissioners and preserve decorum, give such directions as may be deemed necessary to carry into effect the provisions of this charter and perform such other duties as may be assigned him by the commissioners; the secretary shall record the minutes of the meetings of said commissioners in a well bound book and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned him by the said commissioners; in case of the death, disqualification, resignation or declination to servè, of either or both the president or
