Curtis' Point in the Eighth Election District of Anne Arundel County to Dutchman's Point in the First Election District of said County, and all waters on the inshore side of said line shall be deemed to be within the waters of West and Rhode Rivers.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person violating the provisions of this Act shall be liable to a fine of not less than Twenty or more than One Hundred Dollars for each and every offense.

CHAPTER 14.

AN ACT to permit the catching of Brook trout in the waters of Frederick County, Maryland, from March 31st, to July 1st, in each year with rod, line and hook.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be lawful to catch brook trout, from the waters in Frederick County, with rod, line and hook from March 31st, to July 1st, in each year.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That it shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill or destroy any brook trout in any waters of Frederick County, from the 30th day of July to the first day of April in each year, and then only with line and hook, and it shall be unlawful and no person between the 31st day of March and the 1st day of July year catch with rod, line and hook more than 40 brook trout in one day, nor shall any be taken from said stream time less than six inches in length, and any person who violates the provisions of this Section 2 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof by any court of the Peace be fined not less than \$2, nor more than \$100, and the fish so taken, caught, killed or destroyed, and in default of payment of said fine be committed to the Frederick County Jail for not less than five days nor more than 60 days at the discretion of the Justice of the Peace.

SEC. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That all Acts or Ordinances in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
