CHAPTER 140.

Passed Mar. 4, 1835 *An supplement to an act, entitled, an act to Incorporate the Chairmaker's Beneficial Society of Baltimore.*

Name changed *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the name of the corporation incorporated by the act to which this is a supplement, shall be, and the same is hereby altered and changed, and the same shall hereafter be called and known by the name of the United Society of Journey-men Cabinet makers, and by that name shall have and exercise all the powers and privileges conferred by the aforesaid act.*

CHAPTER 141.

Passed Mar. 4, 1835 *An act to continue in force the acts of Assembly, which would expire with the present session of the General Assembly.*

Acts continued in force *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all such acts or parts of acts, as would expire with the present session of the General Assembly, be, and the same are hereby re-enacted and continued in force to the last Monday of December next, and to the end of the session of the General Assembly thereafter.*
